

Blood Sugar planting list

The planting is conceptual and thematic. It combines a primary palette of reds, whites and black with blue accent. Pink plays a minor roll. Species reflect a stylised shady woodland moving to sunshine. Planting can be divided into background, primary structure, linking species, impact, edging and green wall. Below are plant names with links to information.





Background (Hedging)

Prunus lusitanica. Grown here for its solid form and its red stems. Read more here



Primary structure

Prunus branklyn (tree). Grown for its structure. Leaf form and colour and blood red bark. Read more here







Pittosporum Tom Thumb (Shrub). Grown here for its colour, form and as an accent to the primary red. Read more here



Phyllostachy nigra (bamboo). Grown here for colour and verticality to complement other form and provide structure. Read more here



Hebe Red Edge. This plant was used in a limited way to provide sub structure to the composition and for its red tips. Read more here
